


Reflection Golf

You are to design one or more golf holes for a miniature golf course. Show each drawing on a separate sheet of paper. The following stipulations apply:

1. Each hole will require at least the designated number of banks from the tee to the hole.
2. You are to show the path of the ball with a solid line, the projection of the path outside the course will be designated by a dotted line.
3. Show each reflection of the ball, designated by B, B', B" etc.
4. Use dashed lines to show wall extensions.
5. Show your obstacles - these will necessitate the banks.
6. Have fun by coloring your course.

NOTES ON GRADING

To receive at least a C on the project you must successfully complete one hole, Hole #1, which requires one bank. A grade of B will be given for a second hole, Hole #2, which requires two banks (in addition to the first hole). For an A, you must also complete a third hole, Hole #3, which requires three banks (in addition to the first two). Extra credit will be given for designing a fourth hole, Hole #4, requiring more than three banks.
