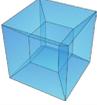
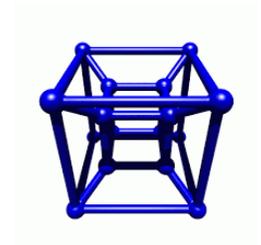

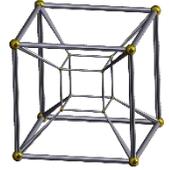

Communicate the Vision & Goal

- State both vision & goal of continuous improvement at each staff meeting.
- Survey random teachers.



Vet the Documents

- Common Unit Assessments aligned to Scope & Sequence posted to the Hub at the beginning of unit
- Common Formative Assessments aligned to Essential Standards



Monitor the Data

- Evidence posted to the Hub at the end of the unit.
- Who gave the Common Unit Assessment?



Walk the Meetings

- Verify attendance.
- Respond to Notes posted to the Hub.
- Coach the Teams in the PLC process.



Focus on Protocols

- Admin Team huddles to discuss walk-throughs.
- Data analysis on PLC protocols.



Celebrate the Results

- Publicly celebrate victories in the PLC process.
- Publicly celebrate victories in advancing the vision and goal.
